## Aprilly:

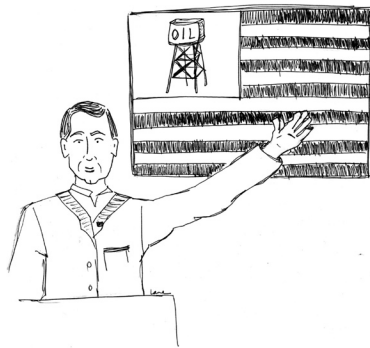
10. Commemorate the four corners out West as the Axis of Good. Show the children that not all in the world is evil.
