
# We Must Amend the Constitution for the Sake of National Security

In the War against Terror, the United States must have free rein to fight its enemies. Against opponents with no morals, we cannot afford to be bound by two-century-old shackles. The Bill of Rights, the foundation of our freedom, must not become a refuge for terrorists. In order to serve the American people, we must amend the Constitution by inserting the phrase "except in cases of national security" at the end of every clause in the Bill of Rights.

For instance, the First Amendment will now read: "Congress shall make no law respecting the establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof, except in cases of national security; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press, except in cases of national security; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances, except in cases of national security."

In doing so, we will be returning the Constitution to the original vision of the Founding Fathers. The Constitution's authors had a very different America in mind than the liberals of today do. Many of our current legal problems are the result of a shift in the usage of certain words. For example, when the authors of the Fifth

Amendment wrote, "no person shall be held in answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a grand jury," they did not use the term "person" as we do today. To them, "person" meant only a patriotic, Christian, Anglo-Saxon man. They certainly didn't intend for the Amendment to be something terrorists like Zachariah Moussaoui, José Padilla or Martha Stewart could hide behind.

So far, most truly patriotic judges have been willing to overlook terrorists' freedoms in order to protect ours. However, there are a few lunatics in California who love terrorists, hate America and even voted for Gore. While I don't particularly care if terrorists nuke San Francisco, the President needs those 55 electoral votes in 2004, and a death toll in the millions could likely push the crucial swing vote left.

Under this new amendment, the system for protecting the homeland will be much more efficient. If someone acts in a suspicious manner, such as walking in a funny way or wearing a turban, the Justice Department can investigate without having

to submit itself to the law. And if they find incriminating evidence in his home—like maps of major cities or the Koran—they can protect society from him without having to go through the technicalities of finding a crime that he's committed. Everyone is better off, except of course the terrorists and their sympathizers.

In order for Americans to keep our freedoms, we must prove worthy of them. Americans should not be allowed to act irresponsibly by defending terrorists in courts, criticizing the government, or practicing Islam. It is important that we stand united. As Americans, we must put aside our differences to fight those who are even more different.

### Mark Trail: The Lost Episodes




